

Proactive strategy for pupils who are known to be a flight risk

- Keypads on doors and code to be changed regularly
- These pupils are always accompanied by an adult when outside the classroom
- Frequent team meetings
- Pupils will go to a secure playground (hardcourt or cubby) at yard times where a teacher and SNAs are on duty
 - a supervising adult monitors pupils needing to use the toilet
 - a supervising adult monitors and ensures gate is closed after pupil enters/leaves the yard
 - those supervising circulate the yard
- Refer to and use “Incredible Years Strategies”
- Frequent meetings with parents. Use home/school communication diary
- Request help from other agencies, i.e. NEPS, CAMHS, KIDS, SESS
- Extra staff deployed when necessary
- Off campus activities are curtailed until the pupil is no longer considered a ‘Flight Risk’
